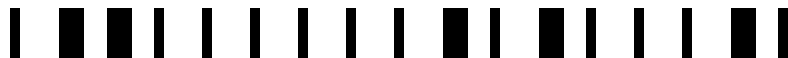

## Index Treatment Adherence (ITA-1)

### Item-specific Instructions:

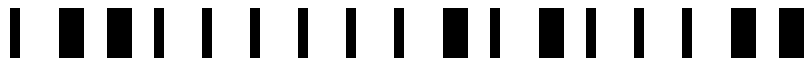
